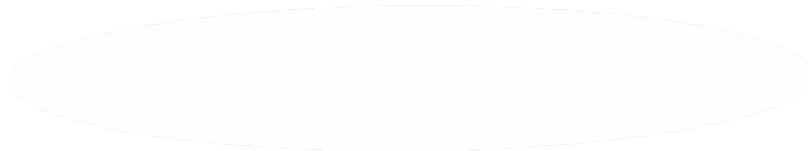

MULTIPLY Ethical Issues Table

Applicants to MULTIPLY are required to identify and deal correctly with any ethics issues that may arise from their research proposal.

Compliance with the relevant ethics provisions is essential from the beginning to the end of the project and is an integral part of any research activity funded by the European Union within Horizon 2020.

Applicants should demonstrate proactively that they are aware of and will comply with European and national legislation and fundamental ethical principles, including those reflected in the [Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union](#) and the [European Convention on Human Rights](#) and its Supplementary Protocols.

In order to identify ethical issues at an early point in the application process, all applicants are required to fill in the Ethical issues table. Furthermore, applicants are requested to explain ethical issues arising from their proposed research in detail in the project outline.

Please be aware that it is the applicant's responsibility to identify any potential ethical issue, to handle the ethical aspects of the proposal and to detail how these aspects will be addressed.

Activities carried out in a non-EU country must comply with the laws of that country AND be allowed in at least one EU Member State.

IMPORTANT: if you reply 'YES' to any of the specific ethical issues below you MUST read the [EC guidance document on dealing with ethical issues](#) and provide full details in your research proposal on how these aspects will be addressed, in accordance with the guidance document.
